CONSTITUTION

ARTICLE I - NAME AND ESTABLISHMENT

The organization shall be known as the Metropolitan University Law Clinic (MULC), established under the Faculty of Law, Metropolitan University, Sylhet.

ARTICLE II - OBJECTIVES

1. To provide free legal aid and awareness to underserved communities.
2. To offer clinical legal education to undergraduate law students.
3. To publish original legal research through the MULC Law Review.
4. To organize moot courts, workshops, and outreach camps.

ARTICLE III - MEMBERSHIP

Membership is open to enrolled students and faculty of Metropolitan University who commit to the clinic's code of conduct and confidentiality obligations.

ARTICLE IV - GOVERNING COMMITTEE

The clinic shall be governed by a committee comprising a Chairperson, Vice Chairperson, General Secretary, Treasurer, and student coordinators, elected/appointed annually.

ARTICLE V - AMENDMENTS

This constitution may be amended by a two-thirds majority vote of the governing committee.
